Also available in 40mm format.

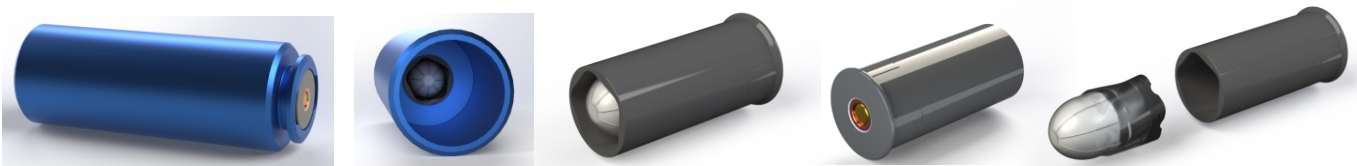

// ARWEN® .67 CAL TRAINING ADAPTER

The ARWEN® .67 cal training adapter allows Para Shot™ .67 cal ammunition to be used in force-on-force training scenarios. It is compatible with ARWEN® 37 multi-shot and ACE single-shot platforms. The systems will load, fire, and eject using the same procedures and drills as standard ARWEN® 37mm munitions. This product is intended to allow training at a substantially lower muzzle energy than the standard AR-1 37mm munition. It is designed to break on impact and deliver an inert powder payload to the target demonstrating a successful hit to the target.

The .67 Para Shot™ projectile is spin stabilized, weighs 2.8g, has a muzzle velocity of 300fps and a muzzle energy of 11J.

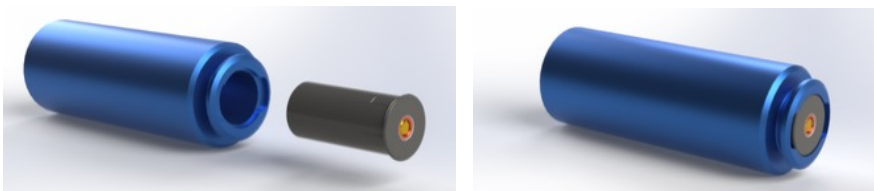


DO NOT USE FOR FORCE-ON-FORCE TRAINING CONTAINS IRRITANT OC POWDER (OLEORESIN CAPSICUM)

Please note that targets must wear protective equipment and clothing for protection. Shots should only be aimed at centre of mass or extremities. All head and groin shots must be avoided. **DO NOT** use the **OC IRRITANT POWDER** variant in force-on-force training. It can easily be identified by the **RED** coloured nosecone.

// LOADING

The Para Shot™ ammunition is installed by pressing it into the ARWEN® training adapter. An inner elastomeric ring will provide an initial resistance when pressing in the Para Shot™ round. Press the round completely into and flush with the adapter.



**DO NOT USE TOOLS OR STRIKE THE
PARA SHOT™ .67 cal AMMUNITION WHILE
LOADING, it contains a conventional
primer and must be treated with all
the same precautions and practices
of live ammunition.**

// UNLOADING

To remove the Para Shot™ ammunition from the ARWEN® training adapter, either fired or not, pull the ammunition rearward out of the adapter. There are two recessed pockets in the rear of the training adapter, if necessary, gently pry the lip of the Para Shot™ ammunition with a flat blade screwdriver or similar tool, until the round is exposed and can be grasped to remove completely.
